


Delta Coal Fact Sheet

Employees and supporting businesses

Delta Coal employs over 250 workers and contractors across both mine sites. Delta Coal also supports local businesses, local communities and local council through direct and indirect spending and contributions.

Location



Chain Valley Colliery is located on the southern end of Lake Macquarie approximately 60 kilometres south of Newcastle. Mannering Colliery is approximately 1.1km south of the Chain Valley Colliery.

OPERATIONAL HISTORY

096

Vales Point Power Station commissioned. Chain Valley Colliery and Wyee State (now Mannering Colliery) were developed to provide coal to the power station.

2011

Miniwall Mining method is established.

2019

1st April 2019 Great Southern Energy Pty Ltd (trading as Delta Coal) became the owners and operators of Chain Valley and Mannering Colliery

The first underground mining at Chain Valley Colliery and Mannering Colliery commenced with the bord and pillar method.

2014

Underground link road established between Chain Valley Colliery and Mannering Colliery. Considerably reducing truck movements and associated environmental impacts.



Environmental Management

- Our Environmental Management System (EMS) provides a framework for the systematic management of environmental issues.
- The EMS covers design, development, production, maintenance and rehabilitation of the operation and its infrastructure.
- We conduct monitoring of meteorological conditions, air quality, water quality, noise levels, subsidence effects, flora and fauna and rehabilitation areas to evaluate the effectiveness of our environmental management processes
- The EMS framework provides standards, procedures, objectives and targets, to help maintain and continually improve on our environmental performance

Achievements

- Chain Valley Colliery and Mannering mine workers and staff successfully navigated through significantly difficult geological structures and geotechnical conditions in 2018
- Transitioned in April 2019 to Delta Coal ownership and alliance with Delta Electricity to retain local, domestic coal supply for Vales Point Power station and NSW's household energy requirements
- Significant improvements have been achieved in productivity through planning and investment in Delta Coal's people and engineering assets
