#### **BUSINESS ARISING**

Two items as business arising from the previous meeting were addressed:

- Voluntary Planning Agreement grants review MMH provided a printed table of the value of approved projects under the VPA and accumulated VPA funding as reported within the Chain Valley Colliery Annual Review. The committee had no further queries on the topic.
- Within the previous meeting members of the committee raised concern that when the VPA grants were being distributed that there was minimal acknowledgement of the source of the funding by the grant issuer (Central Coast Council) and that some members felt that the Council was 'taking credit' for the grants. LM investigated the committee members concerns and noted that on the grants website, that the Chain Valley Colliery community fund appeared to be appropriately referenced, and that Delta Coal was not intending to further address the item with Council. The item was closed out with no further proposed action.

## DELTA COAL OPERATIONAL UPDATE

LM provided an operational update on the mine operations. Notably:

- Partial secondary extraction in HB-East 3 panel commenced in period.
- First workings underway in HB-East 1 Panel.
- First workings completed in HB-East 4
- Partial secondary extraction in HB-West 1 panel.
- Commenced first workings in East Mains
- Production 1 Feb 2025 to 30 Apr 2025 was 263,924 t ROM Coal.

LM provided detail on a name change from Great Southern Energy Pty Ltd to Delta Power & Energy (Chain Valley Colliery) Pty Ltd as well as the Delta Coal website (formerly deltacoal.com.au) being revised and updated to deltapae.com.au.

### APPROVALS UPDATE

### LM Advised:

- Current mining approvals and environmental licenses held by Delta Coal were outlined. All licences and approvals remained the same from the previous meeting with the exception to a minor update to EPL 1770 and EPL 191 to reflect the change in the registered business name.
- Update provided on consent consolidation including most recent correspondence with the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure.
- A brief outline was provided of Delta's scoping work and early consultation with the Central Coast Council for a modification to the Mannering Colliery Project Approval M06\_0311, proposed to permit minor volumes of coal transport to the Vales Point Power Station stockpile.
