Industry Update

discussed the following details with the members.

- Munmorah is to remain in Government ownership and decommissioning preparation continues;
- recent market price (high days in April);
- · Vales Point operating efficiently and great availability;
- NSW spot price history, high prices due to plant not in service;
- increase in Solar PV and exit in coal fired power stations;
- SA generation by fuel type and how SA demand is higher than generation;
- high number wind generation in SA and the need for a reliable base line for supply; and
- SA is looking at interconnector options.

Operational Overview

- advised the members of the following safety details;
- great safety results for apprentices;
- contractors are also performing very well in safety;
- smoking in the workplace is under review;
- extensive PPE catalogue is being reviewed; and
- the trail of Arc Flash protective clothing

Production

• Both VP Units are in service.

- Unit 5 is scheduled for a small outage in September.
- VP Units are achieving great availability results.

Coal Supplies

Chain Valley mine is planning a conveyor delivery option that is due to commence by December 2016.

Trucks

- Biomass deliveries are still continuing, max. 8 trucks per day.
- Vales Point Ash Dam capping limited to 30 trucks per day; actual movements are much less.

Vales Point Outage Projects

- Unit 5 Minor outage is to commence in September and go for 15 days. Works include;
 - 5A CEP and 5A ACW pumps replacements
 - o BFPT HP/IP drains header valve installations
 - ACW pipework replacement
 - Superheater/reheater survey and repairs
 - o 5B FD fan bearing replacement
 - o 5A BCP replacement
 - o AVR modifications
 - o Gen Tx inspections and repairs
 - o Bunkering conveyor maintenance

Environmental Update

Community Enquiries

advised the following environmental and land management issues were raised in the last 3 months

- Concerning the unit 6 return to service (7)
- Night time lighting (1)
- Noise enquiry (1)
- Emissions enquiry (1)

All community enquiries are investigated and appropriate responses and actions are provided.

Compliance

Members were advised by that the power station is compliant for 2015/2016 reporting year with nil breaches. All environmental monitoring data is published on the company website monthly.

Members were briefed on the EPA decision to stop the Lake Macquarie –Wyong Air Quality Monitoring. The EPA advised that the monitoring has served its purpose by demonstrating that the Lake Macquarie-Wyong area consistently experiences good to very good air quality.

Community Update

Open Space Land at Vales Point

informed the members that Delta intends to continue allowing the community to access the open space land at Vales Point Power Station. And confirmed due to reducing cost the lawn maintenance has been reduced in some areas. However, Delta believed that the current maintenance plan represents an appropriate balance taking into account safety, community access and cost.

Community Sponsorship & Events

The members were given an update on recent sponsorship activities and projects which Delta Electricity/ Sunset Power are involved with. It was also explained to the group that Delta recently sponsored the Lake Macquarie City Council, Environmental Research Grant for 2016 and a brief description of the projects was given.
