Production

- Unit 5 currently out of service due to a unplanned outage.
- Unit 6 is now in service after a planned outage in April.
- Unit 5 is scheduled for a major outage in August 2018.

Coal Supplies

- Chain Valley mine mini wall projected to start in June/July 2018.
- · Mandalong mine deliveries via conveyor.
- Wyee Rail Unloader deliveries from Mount Owen Mine.
- Minor volume via trucks.

Trucks

- Biomass deliveries are still continuing.
- Vales Point Ash Dam capping limited to 30 trucks per day; actual movements are much less.

Asset Management Update -

Projects

Discussed the new intermediate ash pumping station project. And the upcoming major outage on unit 5 in August 2018.

He also provided an update on the planned projects for the power station.

Environmental Update -

Community Enquiries

Outlined the environmental and land management issues which were raised in the last 3 months and confirmed that all community enquiries are investigated, and appropriate responses and actions are provided. Also confirmed the Delta Community Incident Information number (1800 115 277).

Compliance

Members were advised by that the power station is compliant for 2017/2018 third quarter. All environmental monitoring data is published on the company website monthly.

Discussed the findings from the recent EPA Audit on the air emissions and licencing requirements for base load power stations in NSW. Additionally, explained Delta's dust emissions data and licence requirements. The findings from the NSW Air Quality Statement 2017 were also shared with the members.

Explained the key facts for the Vales Point Solar project and that the application was recently on public exhibition stage in March, during this time Delta held a Community Information Session, which was well attended.
