Safety and Health Overview

The APHIRM Toolkit is an online software tool designed to support a systematic risk management process. It is evidence based, being developed and hosted by La Trobe University. The Toolkit utilises a participative approach to:

- seek feedback from the people undertaking the work to determine the top physical and psychosocial hazards that may be contributing to development of musculoskeletal disorders, and
- request employee thoughts around causes and possible solutions to identified issues.

Community Enquiries

Environmental update

Details were shared about the aerial application of dust suppressant to the ash dam in November 2024.

Ambient results from the new AQMS and Wyee were shared with the group. This data is available on the Delta website.

Last October 2024 surveillance monitoring of seagrasses within Wyee Bay found a moderate improvement in coverage of Zostera sp.
